CLOTHES

All campers are expected to dress & groom neatly. GIRLS & GUYS: Jeans, appropriate shorts (must meet the "third-finger rule"), casual pants/shirts & t-shirts are fine for the day. No tank tops or yoga pants. GIRLS: Skirts & tops or dresses for evening services and must meet the "third-finger rule". Sundresses and backless dresses must be covered by a jacket. GUYS: Shirts must be worn at all times. Button-down shirts, polo's and casual pants are fine for evening services. SWIMWEAR: No two piece or tankini.

CAMP RULES

Rules are for the protection of each camper & camp property. By registering for camp, you are agreeing to abide by all rules. If a camper does not obey the rules, it is the option of the directors to send the camper home (without refund). If a camper is involved in damaging property, the parent is financially responsible.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Campers are expected to be in assigned areas at all times. Campers and workers are covered with an accident policy (if not already covered by other insurance). A trained nurse is on the grounds 24 hours a day. Emergency facilities are nearby. **PRESCRIBED MEDICATION MUST BE GIVEN TO THE NURSE UPON ARRIVAL AT CAMP.**

REGISTRATION

Pre-Registration is not required but is helpful. Please register as soon as possible. You may pre-register up to June 27. After this date, please register at camp on July 6, 2015 at 8:00 AM.

FEES

\$65.00 per camper

Anyone not registered for the entire week, may register on a nightly basis and will be charged \$20.00 per night. NO REFUNDS

Things PARENTS should know...

You are invited to all services. However, we do ask that you leave within one hour of service being dismissed.

Please do not enter the dorm with or without your camper. Contact Camp Staff, who will be happy to escort you & your camper. This is for the protection of our campers. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

There is a Snack Shack on the grounds. If you wish for your child to purchase items, they will need extra spending money. The Snack Shack is NOT included in the registration fees.
