Have you ever wondered, "Does my work really count for anything?" My 6 year-old son often asks me basically the same thing. He comes to me with his latest Lego creation, and asks, "Dad, look at what I made! Do you like it Dad? Is it good?" He wants to know if what he's done is worthwhile. I say, "It's great. I love it. You did such a great job on it!" I think we all ask the same question of our work. Is what I do good? Does somebody think it counts for something?

Perhaps I should have said to my son what many of us often feel, "No, son, it is not really good because it doesn't have any eternal value. One day it will burn. Your 'Lego-mobile' can't get souls to heaven, so it has no practical spiritual use." But, of course that's not what I tell him. I believe there is real value in what he has done. It has value even if it lasts but a minute before it goes back into the Lego box. It reflects his creativity and his God-given gifts.

How would God answer these questions? Remember in Matthew 3:17 it was Jesus the carpenter of whom God said, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well-pleased." Jesus had just spent 30 years of His life working with wood and stone. And God said of Him, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well-pleased."

Our "Lego creations" matter to Him. This week, try imagining yourself as a child again, holding up your handiwork to your heavenly dad asking, "Is it good, Daddy? Do you like it?" Then, allow yourself to bask in the warmth of His eternal affirmation and



March 15: Church Bowling Party at Edgewood Bowl from 3:00 PM to 5:00 Pm.


Don't forget to discuss Sunday School & Kids Church with your children!
